ADOPT-A-TREE INITIATIVE

What is Greening Milwaukee?

Greening Milwaukee was established to coordinate and actively promote greening activities that will improve our urban environment, educate and train citizens, and increase community wealth, thereby providing for sustainable neighborhoods.

Tree planting on private property is an economic and educational decision for the property owner. In many areas where canopy cover has been reduced, residents may be unable to plant trees due to the cost or lack of information. Over the years, this has left many neighborhoods in Milwaukee without a beneficial tree canopy.

*Greening Milwaukee will conduct a lot evaluation to recommend a tree species and its placement to provide for healthy growth and energy conservation, will contact Digger's Hotline to ensure a safe dig, and will supply a free tree to eligible **Milwaukee citizens.***

How you can qualify:

- *Reside and own property within the City of Milwaukee*
- *Own space to support a large shade tree; ie, approximately 20' from any foundations, overhead wires, competing trees or property lines*
- *Attend a community tree training session and/or receive training information on proper planting/care of your tree www.greeningmilwaukee.org*

Frequently asked questions:

- *Is the tree free? Yes, Greening Milwaukee provides the tree.*
- *Do I plant my own tree? Yes, homeowners will be notified of the day, time, and location for tree pickup and will plant their own tree.*
- *How many trees can I receive? One tree per season.*
- *What if I own more than one property in the City of Milwaukee? One tree per property.*
- *What kinds of trees are available? Nursery stock varies each season; a species will be recommended based on your lot evaluation.*
- *Can I pick the species of tree? No, we will provide species based on available stock. You may indicate a preference, but choice is NOT guaranteed.*
- *How big are the trees? Generally, 1 ½ to 2 inches in diameter; 8 to 14 feet tall.*
- *How big will they grow? Shade trees may grow 60-80 feet tall with a 40 – 50 foot spread.*
